Name	Type	Description
Emarkcertificate	String(300)	Url to emark certificate
Logo	String(300)	Url to retailer's logo
Name*	String(50)	Retailer name
Trustpilot	String(300)	Url to Trustpilot
UnitPrice	Double	Price – e.g. 50.25
UnitPurchaseReference	String(100)	Url to retailer's book detail page

* Required / field value will always be present. Fields without * can be empty
